


# MERTON COURT EY NEWSLETTER

Please ensure mid-morning snacks are of a sensible size and also do not include nuts due to allergies. If your child attends all day please provide them with two snacks clearly separated. The children all have their water bottles at school so there is no need to provide a drink.

### Parking

We have parents/carers within the school who need access to the disabled parking bay (just outside of J1). Please be mindful of this even when in a rush. Please also do not obstruct our school gate, access to field and the passing bays.

### Home School Diaries

Please note that these are always available in the children's drawers and you are welcome to take them home to share with family members. We welcome any photographs or other additions that support your child's interests or developmental progress.

### Forest School

A polite reminder that some of the children's Wellington boots from last

term may be starting to get a little small. They may need replacing and that spare socks are useful for them to have in their drawers.

If you do not yet have one please can we ask that children have a red school ski hat (available from Oz Schoolwear) to remain at school and be worn as part of their Forest School clothing. As the weather is a little chilly it may be useful to bring in an extra jumper as well.

Please note that blazers should be worn to school every day.

Please can you ensure that **all items of school uniform including shoes are clearly labelled with your child's name**. Children should be wearing the School coat available from OZ School wear. Girls hair accessories should be red, yellow, black or grey and be of a simple design (alice band, bow or scrunchy). Children should wear their caps/hats to and from school or baseball caps if in tracksuits and all children should have the correct school bag.

**If girls have pierced ears their earrings will need to be removed for the day on Tuesday (PE), Wednesday (swimming) and Thursday (dance). Also a gentle reminder that the wearing of nail varnish is not permitted for girls.**
