<u>Uniform</u>

<u>Topics</u>

We are starting the Spring Term with our new topic 'Space'. The children will take part in daily craft and messy activities linked to our topic; these will include shaving foam play, ice and water play, and a mixture of other textures. Our subsequent topics will be 'Science' based and we will also be celebrating Chinese New Year. If you have any stories that link to the topics please do share these with us.

<u>Science Term</u>

This term sees a dual focus, crosscurricular link between Science and History. The whole-school topic for this term will be 'A Brief History of Time'! We will be taking part in a 'Wild West' drama workshop, where the children can use their imaginations and go back in time. There will also be a dressing up day along with some space themed activities and science experiments.

Parent Partnership
