# J1 Newsletter Summer 2 2025

Welcome back! We hope you had a great break and are ready for the last few busy weeks of J1!

### **Summer Focus**

This term the whole school focus on Maths continues and we have enjoyed a busy Maths Week! The children thoroughly enjoyed our visit from a magician who showed us everything is not always as it seems. We have been working hard on new maths concepts and developing our addition and subtraction skills.

# **School Uniform**

Please ensure that children have their baseball caps with them every day (including Friday), this is part of their uniform and essential for when they go outside in the warmer weather. May we also remind you that blazers should be worn to school every day.

### **Parents' Evening**

#### **Numeracy**

We will use these last few weeks of term to consolidate the children's learning. We will talk about shapes, clocks, coins and measurement. We will also continue with addition and subtraction, now incorporating counting on and counting back.

# **Literacy**

Continuing our narrative focus, this term we are looking at stories about nature and summer. We will be using the CLPE text "Stanleys Stick" to develop the children's understanding of these topics.

### Letterland

This term we are looking at the 'Hat Man Happenings'. We are discovering that Hairy Hat Man has many adventures and often teams up with other letters to make new sounds like ch, sh, th, and wh. We would encourage you to ask the children to re-tell the stories and try to find the relevant sounds in their reading books each week.

### Homework

We trust that you and the children are enjoying the maths games - they are a fun way of revising the number concepts that we deal with in class. Please may you ensure that these are returned by the following Monday at the latest.

We will continue to send reading folders home twice a week, could we please ask you to write a comment or initial to say your child has read the book at home with you.

The children are decoding well at this level, and we are now encouraging them to take note of the punctuation and use some expression. They should also be able to discuss what has happened in the story to indicate that they have understood what they have read.

The handwriting sheets will focus on the Letterland sound that we are dealing with as we are now practising how to join the letters correctly to write words. Please check that the children remember to start with a 'slide up' and then flow into the following letter – as indicated on the sheet.
